 - schools have benefited from the changes; made budgeting more complicated and unsure what the timeline will look like

 - Virtus has a healthy cash reserve; Kozacki asked if going into the cash reserve, will that interfere with our bond; expressed she would not concerned about bond

- Don Strickland asked if the budget reflects the 2023-2024 school year with the addition of the high school; the budget does not reflect the addition
- Nero stated she would need to estimate what that will look like based on the classroom and what classrooms will need; plans to get with the accountant and come up with the estime
- Don Strickland asked to add the private security to the current budget

- COVID Report
 - o Increase as of late

- (2 students who tested positive and 2 tested positive; 2 students who were quarantined)

- Election Results
 - Carlos Washington and Don Strickland reappointed to the board
 - o Rob Roberts third elected member
- School Security
 - Plan for the remainder of this year and next year
 - Nero: contacted two security companies to get quotes; provided in board packet
 - Security guard will be armed
 - State would not pay; application to apply not available until July; not available until 2023-2024 school year
 - State will only pay if local manpower is available and application is accepted
 - City or County police would be an option
 - Quotes for private security for 2022-2023 school year \$48,000/\$28/hr (Quote 1)
 \$39/hr (Quote 2)
 - Discussion about devices that can be installed for each classroom to provide intruders from coming into the classroom
 - Ducey asked if we knew what the police response time would be; Nero stated it was in the emergency plan
 - Atkins voiced concern about having a plan to get children out of the building if possible.
 - Don Strickland recommended posting signs to remind staff members to ensure doors stay closed/ are not propped open. He also mentioned the front desk being higher vigilant when letting individuals inside the building.
 - Tyner mentioned that morning is the busiest time of day at the front desk.
 - Active Shooter Training will be done at the beginning of the year with the entire school
 - Nero commented that drills can be traumatic for younger students and encouraged conversations and appropriate training for students and staff
 - Atkins asked if parents and students are aware of repercussions of being a weapon; Nero stated that it is clearly defined in the handbook as a recommendation for expulsion.
 - Kozacki- encourage for school to define what exactly qualifies as a weapon/ what emcompasses violation of these policies
